JRSA UPDATE

Financial update:

Treasurer, Ivis provided a financial update. Currently there is £7k of cleared funds in the bank. A proportion of this has already been allocated for Pride Passports and the Prom, leaving £5k. More funds are needed, alongside the current fundraisers such as bingo, bbq, lottery, pre-worn uniform sales and half marathon, more events need to take place to keep funds buoyant.

E-Mail List

Water Fountains

The school is committed to reducing single use plastic and from now, bottled water will no longer be sold and similar for the use of disposable plastic cups. 3 water fountains have already been installed and with a hugely generous donation from a parent who is passionate about reducing the use of plastic, has enabled another 5 to be installed over the summer months.

Gardening and Edible Garden

This is a continuing and important project. The front of the school on both sites look great with pots and planters full of bloom. The grant application which was narrowly missed this year will be edited and resubmitted for next year to Greenwich council. Further grant applications are being worked on by Sam and Lucie, Trustees and Parent volunteers.
