Message from the Principal

Dear Parents/Carers,



As you know, we were the proud recipients of three of the Best in Everyone Awards last week, so I am starting with a photo of our two student winners together with Ms Taylor and Ms Britchfield who travelled up to represent the Inclusion Team. Congratulations to them all!

This week we have continued our successes. Michael in Year 10 excelled himself at the Athletics on Tuesday, securing 1st place in Shot Put and Discus and breaking the record for his age group within the competition. Michael's dedication, commitment and sportsmanship have truly come to light and this achievement highlights his talent and inspires all our students to strive for excellence, underpinning our PRIDE values.

We were also very pleased this week to reach the national finals of the Goldsmith's Community Awards for the third consecutive year. This brings the spotlight on our students who volunteer to go above and beyond to work with the community in a wide variety of ways and we are delighted that this brings national recognition to the school.

Earlier this week we had virtually all of Year 9 in the West End at the theatre to watch the amazing Lion King (we had NO problem finding staff volunteers for the trip!) and also had an Enterprise Team competing in a Pay it Forward competition. This is an inter-school challenge which at this stage was against other United Learning schools. I am thrilled to let you know that our team won this and are now invited to the Grand Final to pitch their product against other schools. The judges will include Levi Roots, Seema Malhotra, Peter Gladwin and Naushad Jivraj and the event will be at the prestigious Drapers' Hall in the City. (I believe that the final is against schools in another well-known academy group!).

Others in Year 9 have been in Braithwaite this week – experiencing the Lake District in the heat and by all accounts having a brilliant week. On top of that, we have the Duke of Edinburgh qualifying weekend.

Next week is no less busy! Year 12 are off to Braithwaite, we have two days of Year 12 induction on Monday and Tuesday and then a day of Year 7 induction on Wednesday. On Tuesday evening we have our new year 7 Parent Information Evening and on Wednesday afternoon our Drama Club are putting on a Showcase Event. Wednesday evening will be our Year 11 Prom. On Thursday we are inviting in to school our new teachers

who will also be joining us in September and then on Friday we can take some time to stop and reflect on the history of the school as it is Founder's Day.

Thursday next week is also Election Day (in case you had forgotten!). We are a Polling Station and so will be guiding our students into the Westcombe Park site from the main road for the day to allow a separate entrance to the Polling Station from the side gate.

Founder's Day FRIDAY 5TH JULY 2024 – this is a key date in our diary and a formal event for everyone at the school. For many years the students of the school have walked down through the park to attend a celebratory concert in St Alfege's Church. Within the church is a large plaque that notes John Roan's gift to the community that founded our school. Our Music Department put on a wonderful showcase of their very best musicians each year and we all remind ourselves of our rich history and the pride we feel as members of the John Roan Community.

The church is no longer big enough for all students in our growing and popular school, so we have some students in the church, together with the musicians (of course) and our VIP guests who are largely Old Roans, but this year will also include the Deputy Mayor of Greenwich. Those who are not able to be at the church will be watching a live feed of the concert in their classrooms. This is also available for parents to watch and we will share the link with you nearer the time.

Following the concert, at around 12.30pm, we will dismiss the students – either from the gate at the bottom of the park or from school.
